

## 4 WEEKS TO GO..

- Arrange your removal company (or enlist the help of your friends and family!)
- Start collecting packing materials
- Notify your utility providers that you're moving, including your energy and water companies and broadband provider
- Arrange internet and telephone lines if you're changing broadband provider in your new home
- Book an electrician and plumber to disconnect and re-fit any appliances you're taking to your new home
- Book any time off work you may need to complete the move

- ☐ Complete a Post Office mail redirection form
- Begin packing up non-essentials you're unlikely to need in the run-up to your move, decluttering along the way

## 7 DAYS TO GO...

to collect your keys!

Notify whoever necessary about your change of address, **Additional Items** such as: Your bank(s) Doctors Your bank(s) Insurances Dentist HMRC Schools DVLA Workplace Local council office • Any memberships, TV licencing clubs & organisations Re-register on the Electoral Roll with your new address Organise necessary pet-sitters or childcare arrangements for moving day Confirm moving arrangements with your removal company Remove any fixed objects not included in your sale Gather all keys for your existing home DAY TO GO... 1 Defrost the fridge and freezer if you are leaving them behind, or switch them to maximum if you're taking them with you Finish packing and pack a separate box or bag of essential items you'll need easy access to on moving day Label items and keys 

Turn off all electrical being left for the appliances new owner HIP HIP HOORAY, it's moving day! Take gas, water and electric meter readings at your old home Ensure all windows and doors are locked Leave keys with the new owners as arranged
